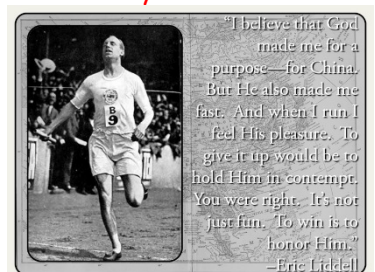
# Geaux Global Spotlight

## Eric Liddell

### Olympic Athlete and Missionary



Eric Liddell excelled in running, and after setting a new British record in the 1923 100 yards sprint, he was considered a great prospect for the Olympics in 1924. Eric Liddell was a committed Christian. During the Paris Olympics, because the heats of the 100 meter sprint were held on Sunday, he withdrew from the race, a race considered to be his strongest event. Instead, he concentrated on the 400 meters since the race schedule didn't involve a Sunday. Liddell was considered to be a strong favorite for the 400 meters. Before the finals, the US Olympic masseur slipped a piece of paper into his hand. It included the words from the Bible 1 Samuel 2:30 "Those who honor me I will honor". Sprinting from the start, Liddell pulled away from the other runners and held onto win gold medal, setting a new Olympic record time of 47.6 seconds. But fame and honor didn't sway him from what he knew was his life calling. After the Olympic games, in 1925, Eric returned to China and used his skills to minister and influence many young Chinese for Christ. He was captured by the Japanese during World War II, but he continued to serve God and his fellow prisoners. He was offered to be part of a prisoner exchange, but gave up his spot for a pregnant woman, who was also imprisoned. Eric passed away of an inoperable brain tumor during his imprisonment. His death left a great empty place in the lives and hearts of the many people who he had spent his life serving. You can read more about him in the book "The Flying Scotsman" and you can watch a movie about his life, "Chariots of Fire".



# Life Group Next Week

**Bible Passage:** Matthew 21:1-17; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19

**Main Point:** People welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem as their King.

**Key Passage:** Because we know that Christ, having been raised from the dead, will not die again. Death no longer rules over Him. Romans 6:9

**Big Picture Question:** Who saves us from our sin? Only Jesus saves us from sin.

## How To Become a Christian

**A – Admit** – You have to admit that you have sin in your life – Romans 3:23 says “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” and repent, or turn away from your sin. (Luke 13:3)

**B - Believe** – Believe that Jesus is God’s Son and receive God’s gift of forgiveness from sin. (Romans 5:8, John 3:16, I Corinthians 15:3-4)

**C – Confess** – Confess your faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. (Romans 10:9-10,15)
