# WHAT IS HEART TO HOME

The **Heart to Home** ministry was introduced to the women of FBC Haughton several years ago and has flourished! This ministry models Christian mentoring from older women to younger women taken from the scripture reference in Titus 2:3-5.

*"Teach the older women to be reverent in the way that they live... to teach what is good. Then they can train the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the Word of God."*

Titus 2:3-5

**Heart to Home** is a small group of ladies who meet once a month in a designated home. The group will share a meal, Bible study, and time of fellowship. The groups consist of Heart Moms who are mature Christian women who teach/mentor the Heart Sisters. Heart Moms will lift up God's Word and train through relationships, lessons, and example, while sharing a home-cooked meal. In each group, the intimate and comforting atmosphere of a home environment will encourage building genuine relationships and connections between generations of ladies at First Baptist Church Haughton.

## WHAT IS A HEART MOM?

A Heart Mom is a Christian woman who honors God with word and deed. She desires to guide and influence a younger sister. She will share her home, heart, and hospitality. She encourages and disciples younger women in God's teachings concerning their roles as women, particularly as wives and mothers.

A Heart Mom may take on any of the following roles:

- A mom who hosts the group in her home, or
- A mom who helps prepare the meal, or
- A mom who helps prepare for the night in various ways, or
- A mom who has studied God's Word and is prepared to lead the group in a time of Bible study and discussion

If you have children, or are of age to have children that have graduated high school, regardless of your marital status, YOU are perfect!

# WHAT IS A HEART SISTER?

A Heart Sister is:

- A young, single woman (18 years or older), or
- A wife/mother with children birth to 12th grade

Heart Sisters agree to commit to a small group for a season (September through May) of **Heart to Home**. She will be a guest of honor at a Heart Mom's home to enjoy hospitality, a meal, friendship, fellowship, and a time of Bible study.

If you have or are of age to have children ranging in birth to 12th grade, YOU are perfect!

## WHEN DO WE MEET?

**Heart to Home** groups will be revealed at our annual banquet in August. You will enjoy a catered meal, meet your Moms and Sisters, and discuss dates for future group meetings.

Due to the time and resources that go into preparing for each monthly meeting, we ask that you respond to your Heart Mom's RSVP or headcount when you receive your invitation or reminder. This is very helpful when preparing.

Also, your Heart Moms work hard to prepare a safe and inviting space to welcome you and your sisters; therefore, no children are allowed at any of our **Heart to Home** meetings.

## TURN AROUND PARTY

Heart Sisters will host a Turn Around Party for their last group meeting in May. This is a time for Heart Sisters to show their love and appreciation for all that their Heart Moms have done during the **Heart to Home** Season. Heart Sisters will receive information about planning your Turn Around Party in January so you and your group will have plenty of time to make decisions and plan a great night.
