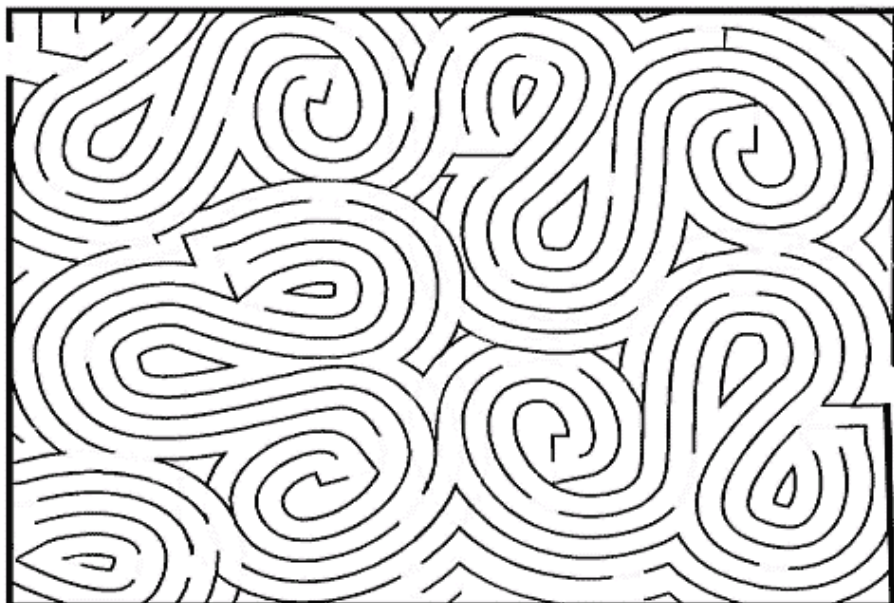

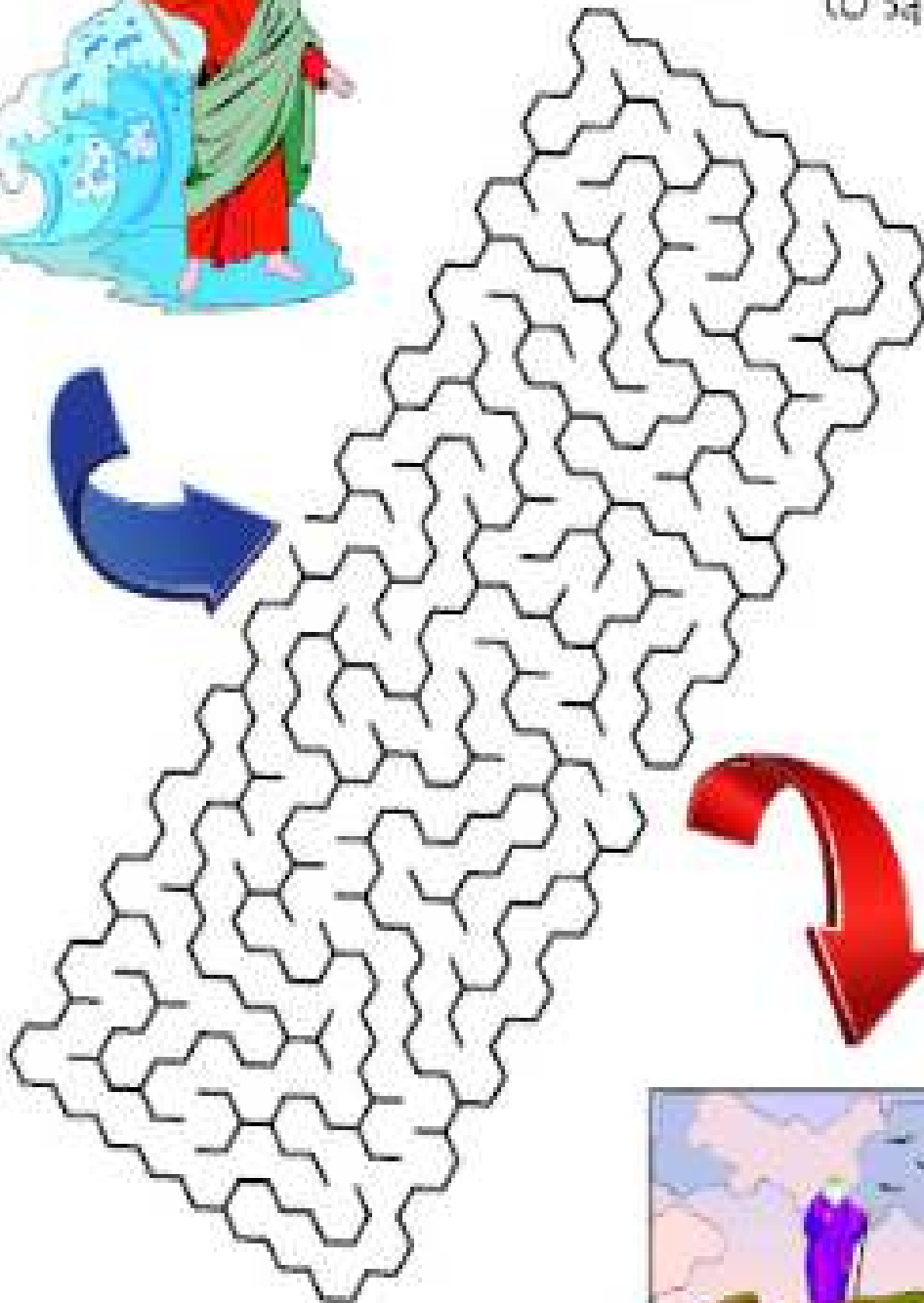

## Mexican Indian Training Center (MITC)

The Mexican Indian Training Center (MITC), one of our Geaux Global Partners, is a seminary for the Mexican Indians in Central Mexico. Located in Cordoba, Veracruz, the seminary houses full-time weekday 60 students and has classes for about 40 weekend students. MITC students, teachers, and short-term missionaries, like the ones sent from FBC Haughton, have helped to establish more than 200 churches throughout southern Mexico. We help build churches, visit orphanages, hold medical clinics, preach, and sing to help share the Gospel with people in Mexico. We have a team of 16 people from the Shreveport-Bossier area who are serving in Mexico this week (January 12-19)!
